

Electrician Job/Educational Opportunity

Applications for the Inside Wireman Apprenticeship program for the 2022 selection process will be accepted on the following days:

Monday, October 24, 2022, through Friday October 28, 2022, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Saturday, October 29, 2022, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

Monday, October 31, 2022, through Friday, November 4, 2022, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

All applications are available for pick up at **Local 649 JATC, 3941 Humbert Rd., Alton, IL.** (Located behind Local 649 IBEW Hall) for each period. **A \$25 nonrefundable application fee is required before receiving application.**

This four-year program is jointly sponsored by the National Electrical Contractor Association (NECA) and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW). Apprenticeship provides a minimum of 144 hours of evening classroom instruction per year, required extensive mathematical usage plus 8,000 hours of on-the-job training.

Applicants must have an official High School diploma or equivalent GED, be at least 18 years of age and show successful completion of one year (two semesters) of Algebra with a grade of "C" or higher on each semester of transcript.

It is **MANDATORY** that a copy of your **High School transcript or equivalent GED accompanies your application. (No Exceptions)**

If applicable, a college transcript or other transcripts may also be submitted with the application.

The final day for completed applications with pertinent paperwork to be returned to the JATC is Friday, November 4, 2022, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. (No exceptions)

Applications are invited from men, women, and members of minority groups. Pre-Employment drug screening, medical physical and background checks after acceptance will be required.
